ARRIVE CAIRO


TUESDAY, JANUARY 23

CAIRO

WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 24

Travel to Giza to view the Great Pyramids and the Sphinx, sole survivors of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. Visit the Egyptian Museum of Antiquities, housing the magnificent treasures of Tut-Ankh-Ahmon. Continue to the Citadel Fortress erected by Salah-ed-Din in the 12th Century. See the Alabaster Mosque and the Sultan Hassan Mosque, and stroll through the winding streets of Khan-el-Khalili Bazaar where artisans and merchants have traded for centuries. **(B,D)**

CAIRO/LUXOR

THURSDAY, JANUARY 25

This morning, fly to Luxor and then transfer to the pier for embarkation on your Nile cruise ship. After lunch, visit the Temples of Karnak and Luxor. Karnak Temple is the largest built by the ancient Egyptians. See the Hypostyle Hall, the Obelisk of Queen Hatshepsut and the Festival Hall of Tuthmosis III. Continue to Luxor Temple, built by Amenophis III for Amun, his wife, Mut, and their son Khonsu. See the fine wall reliefs depicting the daily lives of the pharaohs.

LUXOR/EDFU

FRIDAY, JANUARY 26

This morning you will cross the Nile to the West Bank and Thebes, the burial ground of the great pharaohs of the New Kingdom. Drive past the famed Colossi of Memnon. The highlight of this visit is the Valley of the Kings. See the Tomb of Ramses IV with its varied wall paintings and the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut. Return to your cruise ship where you can relax or sunbathe on the upper deck as you depart Luxor and set sail "up the Nile" (southbound) to Esna. Then continue to Edfu where you will overnight on board.

EDFU/KOM OMBO/ASWAN

SATURDAY, JANUARY 27

This morning, disembark in Edfu to visit the Temple of Horus, the falcon god, protector of the sun, and one of the best preserved in Egypt. Re-board your boat and sail on to Kom Ombo where you see the Ptolemaic Temple dedicated to the two gods, crocodile-headed Sobek and hawk-headed Haroeri. Sail on to Aswan.

ASWAN

SUNDAY, JANUARY 28

This morning, visit the New High Dam, the largest land filled dam in the world. Also see the Unfinished Obelisk. Continue to the Greco-Roman temples of Philae, reconstructed stone by stone on the island of Agilkia. After lunch, board a felucca sailboat and cross one of the Nile's tributaries. Sail around Ele-

phantine Island and see the Mausoleum of Agha Khan. Visit the Botanical Gardens on Kitchener Island then return to your ship. **(B,L,D)**

ASWAN/CAIRO

MONDAY, JANUARY 29

After breakfast this morning you will disembark your fabulous Nile cruise and transfer to the Aswan airport for your short flight back to Cairo and your hotel.

CAIRO - LAND OF GOSHEN

TUESDAY, JANUARY 30

Today we have a full day of travel into the eastern Delta region of Egypt where we will visit the ancient land of Goshen. This is where the Israelites lived during the time of their oppression and some of the villages still reflect life as it was in that time. Highlights include Bubastis, Tanis, Lake Timsah, Pithom as well as the sites of Tell el-Maskhuta and Tell er-Retebah in Wadi Tumilat (time permitting). Return to your hotel in Cairo for overnight.

CAIRO - MEMPHIS/SAKKARA

WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 31

This morning, drive to Memphis, capital of the ancient kingdom. See the Alabaster Sphinx and the beautifully carved statue of Ramses II. Continue to Sakkara and the Step Pyramid of Zoser.


