
LUKE CHANDLER

MONDAY, JUNE 17:

Meet at New York's JFK airport and depart for Israel aboard our transatlantic flights. Dinner and breakfast will be served en route.

TUESDAY, JUNE 18:

Arrive at Tel Aviv in the afternoon. We will meet our guide, journey to Jerusalem, and check into our hotel for dinner and a good night's sleep. We'll use Jerusalem as our base while exploring the southern and central areas of Israel. (D)

WEDNESDAY, JUNE 19: WELCOME TO JERUSALEM

Discuss Abraham, David, Solomon, Jesus, and the Apostles as we explore the Temple Mount. Visit the Pool of Bethesda, the Western Wall and its Tunnels, the City of David, and the fascinating excavations around the Temple Mount. (B, D)

THURSDAY, JUNE 20: THE DEAD SEA

Descend to the Dead Sea to visit Masada and Qumran, famous for the Dead Sea Scrolls. See the oasis of En-Gedi, then finish the afternoon with a chance to float in the Dead Sea. (B, D)

FRIDAY, JUNE 21: KINGS AND KINGDOMS

See Bethlehem then drive to the Judean foothills. Visit biblical Lachish with its connections to Joshua and biblical kings, including Rehoboam and Hezekiah. After lunch go to the valley of Elah where David faced Goliath, visit the site of Gath, and recall Samson and the Ark of the Covenant during a visit to Beth-Shemesh. (B, D)

SATURDAY, JUNE 22: JESUS IN JERUSALEM

Visit the Mount of Olives, Gethsemane, the Kidron Valley, then tour Jerusalem's Old City including Hezekiah's Broad Wall and the likely location of Golgotha. We will eat lunch inside the Old City and enjoy time in one of its markets. In the afternoon visit the Israel Museum to see some of the Bible's greatest archaeological treasures with your own eyes. (B, D)

SUNDAY, JUNE 23: CANAAN'S HEARTLAND

See biblical sites north of Jerusalem including Gibeah (King Saul's city), the cliffs at Michmash (where Jonathan fought the Philistines), the Lebonah Valley, the Tabernacle's original home at Shiloh, and the biblical city of Samaria. (B, D)

MONDAY, JUNE 24: THE JORDAN VALLEY

Visit Jericho, then drive north to Galilee via the Jordan River valley. On the way visit Beth Shean, the Harod Spring (Gideon's 300 men), and Tel Jezreel. Our hotel sits on the shore of the Sea of Galilee, so you can reflect or read by the water, and even wade in as desired. (B, D)

TUESDAY, JUNE 25: JESUS IN GALILEE

Experience scenes from Jesus' early life at Nazareth Village, then visit places from Jesus' ministry along the shore of Galilee including Magdala, the Mount of Beatitudes, and Capernaum. You will also enjoy a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. (B, D)

WEDNESDAY, JUNE 26: NORTHERN GALILEE

Drive north to see stunning biblical remains at Hazor, Dan, and Caesarea Philippi, where Jesus said, "Upon this rock I will build My church." View the Jordan River's three main sources, Mount Hermon (the likely area of Jesus' Transfiguration) and see the route Saul of Tarsus took to Damascus when Jesus first appeared to him. (B, D)

THURSDAY JUNE 27: CAESAREA & JEZREEL VALLEY

View Deborah's battlefield by Mount Tabor then visit Nain, where Jesus raised a widow's son. Cross the Jezreel Valley to visit Megiddo then ascend Mount Carmel to the area of Elijah's contest with the Baal prophets. After lunch we will visit the magnificent ruins of Caesarea and its famous harbor, then drive to the airport. The impact of this marvelous, meaningful experience is only beginning as we board our flights home. (B)

PAYMENT SCHEDULE

- Deposit of \$500 per person due with registration. (\$100 of this amount is nonrefundable)
- Remaining tour balance due by March 1, 2024

PAYMENT METHODS

CANCELLATION POLICY

Trip cancellation for any reason will result in nonrefundable penalties as follows:

- More than 99 days before departure: \$100
- 99 to 61 days from departure: \$2,000
- 60 to 51 days from departure: \$3,200
- 50 days or less from departure: Full price of tour

TRAVEL INSURANCE

Comprehensive Travel Insurance is strongly recommended to protect your trip investment. Recommended coverages include Trip Cancellation or Interruption, Medical Expense, Emergency Evacuation/Repatriation, and Baggage delay/loss. The availability of some coverage levels may be subject to time constraints, so it is recommended to purchase protection shortly after booking.

SURCHARGES: DOLLAR FLUCTUATION

Local prices in Israel are based on the New Israeli Shekel (NIS). Tourism service providers have determined that any additional costs resulting from currency fluctuations that lower the Bank of Israel exchange rate lower than NIS 3.4 per US Dollar (at time of arrival) will be borne by tour participants.

REQUIRED TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

A passport valid for at least 6 months after the return date of the trip is required for travel. Travelers with passports expiring less than 6 months after the return date may be barred from entering the destination country. It is the sole responsibility of the passenger to check the passport expiration date. For U.S. citizens, Israel issues free visas upon passenger arrival.

It is the sole responsibility of the traveler to have all required travel documents for travel and entry to Israel, and for re-entry into the United States.
